GUIDELINES FOR JURYING

Jurying Chair – Helen Jenson (928) 671-1149

Categories These categories were approved by the Board in 2014.
If you have other media, please contact jurying chairperson.

- **Acrylic**
- **Drawing** Charcoal, Colored Pencil, Scratchboard, Pen/Ink.
- **Jewelry**
- **Mixed Media** Any combination of two (2) or more mediums.
- **Oil**
- **Pastel**
- **Photography** Standard and/or digital.
- **Sculpture** Free standing or wall-hanging three-dimensional art pieces made of clay, wood, metal, stone, glass, paper-mache, gourds or similar materials.
- **Watercolor**

Rules for Submitting Art Work (Current Club Members only)

- Submit three art pieces in the medium of your choice (see category list for direction). Each category must have 3 items specific to that category.
- Art pieces must have been created within the last 3 years.
- No copies or giclees are permitted. All artwork must be originals created by you.
- All hanging artwork must be framed, backed and have wire hangers. (No saw-tooth hangers).
- Artwork must be presented with clean frames, glass and matting with no damage.
- Gallery wrap canvases are allowed when canvas measures at least one inch in width, with sides painted and wired to hang.
- Forms must be completed, including “Hold Harmless Agreement and Statement of Originality.”
- After signing up and completing forms, you will receive a packet of information about the jury date and time by E-mail prior to the date.

Judges Evaluation

- Composition - does artist understand how to create art showing focal point.
- Use of color, technical use of medium, drawing skills, values and texture.
- Originality in design.
- Presentation - Has artists shown art work in complementary frame and matting.

During the judging the room will be closed to everyone accept judge and attendant. Judge's results are kept confidential and will be returned to the artist. Each medium will be judged separately and must have at least two votes of “yes” by the judge to pass. All comments by the judge should be viewed as constructive aids to grow your skills as an artist. If you do not pass, we encourage you to try again by submitting fresh artwork at a future jurying event.

Educational opportunity coming in late September

David Dunlop is a **painter**, a teacher, a lecturer, and the writer and artist on the Emmy Award-winning PBS series ***Landscapes Through Time with David Dunlop*** and other **DVDs** about painting. He lives and paints in Connecticut and writes about his thoughts of art on his **Art Blog**.

Rick McGill will present a series of videos done by David Dunlop, who teaches art history and perfecting your art. The series will be about famous artists who were involved in the impressionist movement of the late 19th century.

Dunlop teaches the history techniques of each artist while painting their subject matter in the location of the painting. After watching this series, which will begin in late September, we will discuss those techniques and how we can incorporate them into our own artistry. This type of painting was called “en plein aire,” which means painting outside. We will partake of this info by painting outdoors at several locations around the area.
