Six Nonprofits Selected to Benefit from 19th Hole Concerts

Six Archuleta County nonprofits have been selected to benefit from the 19th Hole Concerts at The Pagosa Springs Golf Club. The 19th Hole Concerts pairs a nonprofit with a local music talent on Thursday evenings June 15 through July 20 to offer a fun evening of entertainment. Food from the grill and signature cocktails will be available for purchase. Concert goers should bring a camp chair or blanket and leave your dogs at home. The cover charge is a \$10 donation which supports the six nonprofits selected for the 2017 concert series. At the end of the series, all proceeds are pooled and distributed equally to the six featured organizations.
