After the fire last weekend, the community support has been incredible and very appreciated. With a little help from our friends, we have been able to keep patient care and community access available and identify and secure some clinic space. Axis Health System, Pagosa Springs Behavioral Healthcare office resumed some operations on Monday at the Catholic Education Center (CEC) located at 462 Lewis Street. This was a temporary location planned to be used through Friday, November 4 to support basic patient care and community crisis response access while we identified another space to relocate to.

We are pleased to announce that beginning Monday, ***November 7, Pagosa Springs Behavioral Healthcare will be back to full operations at 46 Eaton Drive, located behind City Market.*** We will resume providing our full continuum of care at this new location from Nov. 7 through May 2017, when there is a planned move to the new Archuleta Integrated Healthcare clinic, which is currently under construction. While this interim move was clearly unplanned and required as a result of the fire, we are moving quickly to restore services in a manner that will accommodate our patient and community needs until such time that our new facility is available.

**Through November 4 at the Catholic Education Center we are:**

- Providing individual therapy, case management and limited psychiatric appointments;
  - All groups are suspended until November 7.
- Providing community crisis walk in access and support.

**As of November 7 at 46 Eaton Drive we will:**

- Resume full care operations, including all groups at their established/scheduled times;
- Resume same day access enrollment.

The Pagosa staff, is and will continue to be, available at the phone numbers you normally call. The same is true of our main clinic numbers 264-2104 and 264-2108 (fax). Axis staff have available and reachable post the fire and are focused on providing the care and access that are important to our community and our patients.

Please know we are available for crisis calls and walk-ins as usual. Our 24/7 crisis line, 247-5245, is also available. Our website is frequently updated with new information as changes unfold. Please find us at: [www.axishealthsystem.org](http://www.axishealthsystem.org).
