

# SCHOOL DRESS CODE

It is the desire of Trinity to maintain an environment in which children can learn. A student's dress and grooming must not disrupt the educational learning process or interfere with the maintenance of a positive learning environment. Part of the environment is appropriate dress. Parents **MUST** take primary responsibility in monitoring what their child wears to school. We would expect that all students and parents would adhere to this policy without difficulty.

Trinity reserves the right to determine if immediate revisions to the dress code are necessary. All such revisions would be approved by the administration. Interpretation of policy items will be made by the administration.

***The following are not acceptable: worn, torn, baggy/oversized or dirty clothing, clothing that drags on the floor, pants that reveal any portion of the undergarment or skin. Tops/shirts must completely cover the entire midriff during normal activities. Jewelry or accessories must be modest and not be a distraction. Additional body piercing (aside from earrings), tattoos and other body ornamentation are not acceptable. Hair is to be neat, clean and groomed in natural color tones. Caps and hats may only be worn outdoors. Undergarments which show beneath the hem of a shirt or top must be of the same approved color as polo shirts.***

***\*\* No logo, design, stripe, color banding, decoration, or writing of any kind will be allowed on tops, blouses, shirts, sweaters, vests, or fleece. Trinity logos are acceptable. Bottom clothes such as pants, shorts, skorts, skirts or Capri pants may have a small pocket type label only.***

## ENFORCEMENT OF THE DRESS POLICY

1. First infraction - teacher speaks with the student.
2. Second infraction - the student receives a written warning. This warning is to be signed by the parent and student, and then returned to school the following day.
3. Third infraction - the student's parent is called and asked to bring appropriate clothing to school. The student will remain out of class until the change of clothing is brought to school. This will result in a tardy. If the parent is unable or unwilling to bring a change of clothes, the student will serve a detention.

Fleece	Pullover Fleece ¼ Zip or Full Zip Jacket or Vest NOTE: A blouse, polo or turtleneck must be worn under the article.	Any solid colors. <b>NO LOGOS, EXCEPT TRINITY LOGOS.</b>
Pants	Twill or Corduroy Pleated or Flat Front (Uniform style Pants) <b>NOTE: NO CARGO STYLE OR SKINNY LEGGED PANTS OR LEGGINGS</b>	Solid Khaki, Solid Navy, or Solid Black.
Shorts	Twill Pleated or Flat Front Shorts. <b>NOTE: NO CARGO STYLE SHORTS</b> (Shorts may be worn in August, September, October, April, May and June ONLY.)	Solid Khaki, Solid Navy, or Solid Black. <b>NO LOGOS.</b>

Capri	Twill Capri	Solid Khaki, Solid Navy, or Solid Black
Skirt & Skort	Twill Skirt Twill Skort	Solid Khaki, Solid Navy, or Solid Black
Jumper	Twill	Solid Khaki, Solid Navy, or Solid Black
Tights/Nylons	Solid colored tights or nylons must be worn.	Solid White, Solid Khaki, Solid Navy Solid Black
Shoes	Heel height about 2 inches or less. Tennis or gym shoes, dress shoes, sandals with heel straps are required in gr. K-4.	
Accessories	Any accessory (socks, jewelry, hair accessories, etc.) which becomes a distraction to learning may be asked to be removed at the teacher's discretion.	

**\*\*LENGTH OF SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS AND JUMPERS MUST BE APPROPRIATE (I.E., MUST BE BELOW THE END OF THE LONGEST FINGER WHEN ARMS ARE AT THE SIDE).**

Sweaters	V-Neck NOTE: A shirt, polo or turtleneck must be worn under the sweater.	<b>NO LOGOS.</b>
Fleece	Pullover Fleece ¼ Zip or Full Zip Jacket or Vest NOTE: A blouse, polo or turtleneck must be worn under the article.	Any solid colors. <b>NO LOGOS, EXCEPT TRINITY LOGOS.</b>
Pants	Twill Pleated or Flat Front Corduroy Pleated or Flat Front <b>NOTE: NO CARGO STYLE PANTS</b>	Solid Khaki Solid Navy Solid Black
Shorts	Twill Pleated or Flat Front Shorts. <b>NOTE: NO CARGO STYLE SHORTS</b> ( <i>Shorts may be worn in August, September, October, April, May and June ONLY.</i> )	Solid Khaki Solid Navy Solid Black
Shoes	Heel height about 2 inches or less. Tennis or gym shoes, dress shoes.	
Accessories	Any accessory (socks, jewelry, hair accessories, etc.) which becomes a distraction to learning may be asked to be removed at the teacher's discretion.
