



CITY COUNCIL'S MESSAGE:

June 21, 2018

Prior to the start of the June 12 City Council regular meeting, Council held a closed session meeting for the purpose of discussing pending litigation.

During the “Council Reports” portion of the June 12 City Council meeting, Councilman J.B. Feeley mentioned that there is a bill on the Governor’s desk to ban “vaping” and smoking on beaches in New Jersey – and if the bill passes, the City should have a plan in place regarding how to notify and educate the public (if and when that bill goes into effect).

There were eleven (11) Resolutions on the June 12 Consent Agenda and each were approved by City Council.

During the “Citizen Comment” portion of the June 12 meeting, a resident asked about the possibility of adding an area in Sea Isle City for dogs to run and get exercise – especially since there is a large dog population in our community and dogs are not permitted on the beach during the summer season. At that time, Business Administrator George Savastano explained that there is money in the Capital Plan to explore and design a possible dog park in Sea Isle City; however a location for the park has not yet been determined.

Also during “Citizen Comments,” a resident expressed concerns regarding alcohol being seen on the beach over Memorial Day Weekend. It was explained that the Sea Isle City Police Department had a heavy presence on the beach over Memorial Day Weekend and they wrote many tickets for open containers and underage drinking. Additionally, City Council has been assured that there will be a strong police presence on the beach throughout the summer.

Our next City Council meeting will be a re-organization meeting on June 26 at 10:00 a.m. At that time, Council will appoint a new City Council President for the following year.
