## UW-Eau Claire

We continue to use the UW System application (not The Common Application) for admission decisions. Applications and all required materials received by December 1 received priority consideration; those received after February 1 will be considered on a space-available basis. Starting this fall, all applicants are required to submit a \$50 application fee.

### Scholarships

Incoming freshmen will find support for their education through a variety of merit-based scholarships that we offer. Some scholarships are awarded automatically based on a student's academic profile, while others require a separate scholarship application. Students should have submitted the scholarship application by our priority deadline of December 1 for early awards and February 1 for all other awards. ## UW-Green Bay

### Admission

We gladly continue to accept students' applications. Please let us know what we can do to help your students complete their applications. We can reach out to their schools, provide information about writing a great essay, or anything else they might need. Please remember, a complete application requires the student's official ACT score. After applications are completed, decisions are typically completed within two weeks.

### Scholarships

Students admitted with at least a 3.0 GPA and a 23 on the ACT (1140 on the SAT) are eligible to apply for new freshman scholarships at UW-Green Bay by visiting <http://www.uwgb.edu/scholarships/new-freshmen/>. The deadline is early: students must complete the application by February 15, 2017 for consideration.

## UW-La Crosse

### Admissions

Seniors are encouraged to complete their applications before the priority deadline of February 1. Students can expect an admission decision 3-4 weeks after all of the required application materials are received (UW System application, application fee, official high school transcript, and official ACT/SAT scores). Students placed on the postpone list should follow the recommendations sent to them to strengthen their applications.

Admitted students should submit the enrollment deposit and complete the on-campus housing process immediately as students are placed in the residence halls on a first-come, first-served basis.



## Scholarships

There are multiple ways to receive scholarships at UWL. Scholarships available through the UWL Foundation Office require an application and have a deadline of February 1. Students are also considered for merit scholarships based upon their admission application materials. To be considered for these scholarships, all admission materials need to be submitted before the deadline. Scholarship opportunities are also available through our Scholarship Resource Center. ## UW-Madison

### Admissions

Our fall 2017 freshman application deadline is February 1, and our transfer deadline is March 1. Freshman applicants will receive a decision by the end of March, and transfer applicants will hear by the end of April.

Our fall 2016 class includes 6,430 freshmen—3,671 of which are Wisconsin residents—and 1,091 transfer students—746 are from Wisconsin.

UW-Madison successfully went live with the Common Application on August 1. Students can apply using either the UW System Application or The Common Application. Our application fee has also increased from \$50 to \$60, as of August 1.

### Admissions

Thank you for your continued assistance in the application process. We are in crunch time just like you. We especially appreciate your help in encouraging students to finish their applications. Providing a general reminder that applicants submit their best ACT/SAT test scores will help not only with processing, but with positive admissions outcomes. We anticipate accepting new applications throughout the spring; however, there are many advantages to applying prior to the end of 2016.

### Scholarships/Financial Aid

With the change in the FAFSA filing, UW-Oshkosh has moved the priority filing date to December 20, 2016. Regardless of timing, all students are encouraged to file. We expect awards to begin likely in February with priority given to the earliest filers. The change in the FAFSA filing also has impacted the scholarship application deadlines. A scholarship that does not have a deadline is the Academic Excellence Scholarship. Your Wisconsin Academic Excellence Scholar can earn an additional \$2000 for tuition; 50% coverage of room and board; \$400 for books plus a \$1500 work opportunity over and above the State's award of \$2,250 for each of 4 years.
