ENROLLMENT + HOUSING

Admitted freshmen must submit their \$100 enrollment deposit and \$75 housing deposit (if applicable) by May 1 (refundable until May 1). Students should submit their \$100 enrollment deposit early, as orientation information is only sent to deposited students beginning in mid-March.

Housing is guaranteed for all incoming students if the \$75 deposit and housing application are received by April 20. Assignments are first-come, first-served.
