Gift Safety Guidelines:

Because Cincinnati Children's is committed to the health and safety of their patients, the following guidelines have been established for gift donations:

- All donations must be new and in original packaging. Must have the manufacturer and store tags still attached. For the safety and welfare of the patients, they cannot accept any used items.
- All items must be non-toxic. This information must be available on a tag or on the item's packaging.
- All items must be latex-free.
- Handmade items, including greeting cards, cannot be accepted.
- Unable to accept stickers or crafts containing stickers without prior approval from Child Life and Integrative Care.
- Items are not to be gift wrapped.
