The exhibit consisted of 65 photos of more than 20 of the many and varied cultures, many of them immigrants, that are Hartford. In some there is a sense of shyness or uncertainty that likely reflects their unfamiliarity in their new home. All of them convey the richness of humanity that is Hartford.
