COURSES DESCRIPTION:

(1) BASIC COURSE – *Lay Speaking Ministries*.

The required beginning course for local lay servant certification; course topics: Leading, caring, communication, serving. It offers guidelines for best practices as a church leader and outlines a number of ministries in which lay servants may assume roles.

(2) ADVANCED COURSES

God's Mission – Our Journey - a study to help gain a better understanding of and a more holistic approach to participation in God's mission to the world. This course will help equip lay servants for more effective missional engagement in their communities and beyond as well as provide the theological and foundational training for mission volunteers, UMWIM teams and leaders, and individuals.

Justice in Everyday Life - An in-depth look at the Social Principles of The United Methodist Church — the church's attempt to speak on contemporary issues with which it is confronted today. The book covers topics such as the following: Natural World, Social Community, Economic Community, Political Community, Biblical Foundations of the Social Principles, and Teaching the Social Principles. It is not only for Lay Servants but is for anyone interested in studying the Social Principles in greater detail.
