Firefighters and Marines will be joining forces to collect and distribute toys for youth in need. Over the past two and a half decades, Spark of Love Toy Drive has successfully collected more than nine million toys. The campaign collects new, unwrapped toys and sports equipment for underserved children and teens in Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Orange, Ventura and Riverside counties.

Our goal is to exceed last years' collection of half a million toys. The promotion for the 26<sup>th</sup> year of the toy drive will begin on Monday, November 12, 2018. On Friday, November 30, 2018, we will host the first of our Stuff-A-Buses at the Mathis Brothers store in Ontario from 4:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., where our viewers and participants can drop-off their new, unwrapped toys or sports equipment. Various ABC7 Talent will be available to meet and greet viewers and participants as we collect toys for children and teens. The toy drive will run through December 24, 2018.
