- Ability to commit the time and resources to serve on Board, committees, and attend ICPHSO events, and
- Links with one of ICPHSO's stakeholder communities (i.e. – manufacturing, retail, trade association, non-profit organizations, consumer advocacy organizations, safety organizations, legal, standards, testing, consulting, academic/research).
