MUSIC TOGETHER®

This series of mixed-age classes features music, playful movement activities, and instrumental jam sessions for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers. The class offers a research-based, developmentally appropriate music curriculum with emphasis on adult involvement and entire families enjoying and making music together. A parent or caregiver must accompany each child to class.

RHYTHM KIDS

Rhythm Kids® is an exciting NEW music, movement, and drumming class supporting the Music Together® philosophy that all children can complete the pathway of early childhood music development from birth through age 8. Children will sing, dance, move, drum, and play to songs and beats from around the world while they integrate and assimilate rhythm in new ways. This class is offered for two age ranges: 4-5 and kindergarten-2nd grade. Parents have the option of sitting in class but are not required to do so.

LITTLE DRUMMERS

For children ages 3-5 who are ready for a big kid music class, Little Drummers incorporates all the elements of a family music class within a more independent learning environment. Children learn basic music terminology, try instruments like the clarinet and trombone, and receive a broad musical foundation to prepare them for a lifelong love and appreciation of music.
