Who Can Enter

All IFDA New England chapter members are invited to submit their projects to the 5th IFDA New England Design Showcase + Awards Event.

Professional Interior Designers who are IFDA-NE members can submit their projects for all of the following categories:

- Best Kitchen Design
- Best Bath Design
- Best Living Space Design
- Best Specialty Space Design
- Best Custom Design

*All entries must be the sole work of the entering Professional Interior Designer who is an IFDA-NE member.

Professional Members who are IFDA-NE members can submit their projects for the ***Best Custom Design*** category.

If entry is a **Group Project**, one member of the group must be an IFDA-NE member. The project can be entered as a collaboration/group project and must have full group participation – see Team Entries on following page.

Student Members who are IFDA-NE members can submit their projects for the Student Design category.

Projects must be completed - the completion date can be from any point in the designer / vendor's career.

Members may re-submit non-winning designs from previous years for this award.

Team Entries

If a project entered into the Best Custom Design category was created via a team collaboration, it can be submitted as a Team Entry and include up to 4 team individuals who will receive recognition for their work on the project. Teams should total between 2-4 individuals (entrant + 2-3 individuals). ***Team individuals do not have to be members of IFDA-NE but the main entrant does.***

If submission is selected as a winner, the trophy or award will be presented on behalf of the team to the Entrant listed at the top of the entry form. That person must be an IFDA-NE member. Additional team individuals listed on the entry form will be announced at the time of the presentation.

If any team individual would like a copy of the trophy in their name, they can complete an order form and submit a payment of \$45 for the production and shipping of each award. An email with ordering instructions will be distributed after the winners have been announced.

Categories

- 1. Best Kitchen Design (open to professional interior designer members)**
The winner of this category will be determined based on functionality, creativity and overall design in a kitchen space.
- 2. Best Bath Design (open to professional interior designer members)**
The winner of this category will be determined based on functionality, creativity and overall design in a bathroom space.
- 3. Best Living Space Design (open to professional interior designer members)**
The winner of this category will be determined based on functionality, creativity and overall design in a living space.
- 4. Best Specialty Space Design (open to professional interior designer members)**
Specialty spaces are defined as areas that are designed for a specific use. Examples include but are not limited to show houses, commercial spaces, outdoor rooms, media rooms, home offices, pool house, spa, etc. The winner of this category will be determined based on functionality, creativity and overall design in a specialty space.
- 5. Best Custom Design (open to all professional members – individual or team)**
The winner of this category will be determined based on craftsmanship, creativity and overall design of a custom designed element in a room that includes but is not limited to either furniture, cabinetry, millwork, flooring, fireplace, stonework, faux finishes, etc.
- 6. Student Design Award (open to all student members)**
The winner of this category will be determined based on functionality, creativity and overall design on a project that was completed as coursework during a student's current education program. Students should review the Student Design Award requirements and submission checklist for more information.
- 7. Community Service Award (open to all members)**
Judges will select an IFDA member for his or her outstanding contributions to charitable and/or community service endeavors. A nomination form is required for this category. Self-nominations are allowed.

Judges Panel

Design New England will invite an esteemed panel of judges to include a design writer, 2 members of the design education community, and members of DNE's editorial staff, including editor-in-chief, Gail Ravgiala.

Judging will be blind – all submissions will be presented to the judges' panel without reference to designer's name or company.

Deadlines & Dates

Submission deadline: Thursday, September 29, 2016

Winners will be announced at the Design Showcase + Awards Event on **Wednesday, October 26, 2016**.

All entrants are required to attend the Design Showcase + Awards Event in order to participate in promotional opportunities.

IFDA-NE's VP of Programming will be responsible for selecting and displaying the Designer's "Showcase" image.

IFDA-NE Student Design Award

Eligibility:

- Students from academic year 2014-2016 are eligible, and must have been or are enrolled in a Certificate Program, or Interior Design degree program (2 year, Bachelor, or Masters).
- Student must be a member of the IFDA---NE Chapter and of 18 years of age or older.
- Students must include a copy of their school ID card as an attachment to their entry form.
- All entries must be the sole work of the entering student.

Entry Requirements:

- Students may submit up to two entries for this award each year.
- Students must complete an entry form for each entry and pay the entry fee.
- Entries must be completed at any time during student's current educational program.
- All entries must be based on residential space or part thereof including whole residence, combination of rooms or single room (i.e. bedroom, living space, kitchen, bath, etc.)
- Images of rendered floor plans, elevations, sketches and material boards should be submitted based on instructor's coursework.
- Students must submit a copy of the assignment from the instructor, and their project design statement.
