Dr David Seiden is a Florida Licensed Medical Doctor who received an MS in Physiology & Biophysics and a Doctor of Medicine from Georgetown University in Washington, DC. After an internship in Internal Medicine at St Luke's Roosevelt Hospital, a residency in Neurology at Columbia Presbyterian Medical in New York and a fellowship in Sleep Medicine at Mount Sinai Medical Center in Miami Beach, Dr Seiden became certified in Sleep Medicine by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology and the American Board of Sleep Medicine, and certified in Neurology by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology.
