

# Erin Kelly Memorial Scholarship Fund

Part of the mission of Summerville Catholic School is to make a Catholic education affordable to as large a part of the Catholic Community as possible. We try to accomplish this objective of minimizing tuition rates by utilizing parish subsidies, a variety of fund raising efforts, and keeping our operating costs low.

**The Erin Kelly Memorial Scholarship Fund**, a tuition assistance program, was established in 1988 to provide help to families who otherwise would be unable to attend Summerville Catholic School. As a tribute to the Kelly family for their vision and continued support of Summerville Catholic School, two individual \$1,000 tuition scholarships will be awarded in memory of Erin Kelly for the 2017-2018 school year.

## Scholarship Criteria:

- ❖ Parents and student attend one of our supporting parishes; St. John the Beloved, St. Theresa the Little Flower, Immaculate Conception, St. Thomas the Apostle, or St. Philip Benizi Church.
- ❖ Parents are considered to be in good standing with one of the above churches as determined by the respective church office staff.
- ❖ Student will be in attendance at SCS for the upcoming school year as a 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grader.
- ❖ Student is in good academic standing - based on the *average* of grades at the end of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters.

In addition, he/she must exhibit conduct that is becoming of a Summerville Catholic School student as outlined in the *Summerville Catholic School Handbook for Parents/Students*.

- ❖ Student completes an application and adheres to the timelines established.

3. Two letters of recommendation – one from a current teacher at Summerville Catholic and one from a non-SCS related person who is not a relative or family member.

All **completed** applications must be received by the Principal by **Friday, May 11th**. There will be **no** exceptions. Applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of one SCS Advisory Council member, one SCS upper school teacher, one SCS lower school teacher, and the principal. Based on the criteria established the recipient will be chosen for the Erin Kelly Memorial Scholarship Award.

The scholarship will be awarded by a member of the Kelly Family at the 2017-2018 Special Area Award's Ceremony. This scholarship will be applied to the student's *tuition* for the upcoming 2018-2019 school year.
