## Virtual Community Health Worker Core Competency Pilot Training



**Are you ready to make a difference in your community?**

Join us for a FREE Community Health Worker (CHW) Core Competency Curriculum Pilot training that will help you build skills, deepen knowledge, and succeed in the CHW profession. Participants in this training will develop essential competencies in communication, advocacy, coordination of care, and cultural responsiveness.

- To be eligible to apply for the Kansas State CHW certification, participants must complete classroom instruction (100 hours) with real-world service learning (60 hours).
- This pilot fulfills the 100 hours of classroom instruction required for Kansas CHW certification and provides up to 30 of the 60 required service-learning hours.
- The course will begin Feb. 2 and end May 1, 2026 (see QR code below for course schedule).

### Eligibility

- ✓ 18 years or older
- ✓ At least a GED or high school diploma
