PATH OF JESUS (116037) Seven short dramas of the life and teachings of Jesus: Introduction (1 min.); **The Christmas Story** (9 min.); The Temptation (5 min.); Jesus and the Pharisees (10 min.); The Pharisee and the Tax Collector (8 min.); The Decision (6 min.); The Absent King (10 min.); The New Covenant (13 min.). The DVD also includes a director's commentary for each story containing behind-the-scenes information that leaders may want to show before or after each segment. Includes guide. Age: Upper elementary - Adult

CHRISTMAS CRAFTS AND ACTIVITIES (805213) A Practical Guide for Christian Education Directors and Sunday School Teachers. This book includes craft, game, activity, story, and snack ideas for teachers of preschool, lower elementary, and upper elementary children.

This Advent book contains family devotions that focus on connecting Jesus and the symbols of Christmas. CHRISTMAS SHOPPE: AN ADVENT EXPERIENCE FOR CHILDREN (812068) Author: Flegal, Daphna and Stoner, Marcia. 'The Christmas Shoppe' is an event where children of all ages hear the Christmas story, create Christmas symbols to be sold to support a mission project of the church's choice, and prepare and participate in a worship service with parents or with the entire congregation. Includes plans for a one-day, weekend, or four-week option. Children rotate through six departments: angel, manger, candy cane, star, card, and bakery. In each department, children hear part of the Christmas story and make items for the sale. The second portion of the event deals with preparing for a closing worship presentation and setting up for the sale. An accompanying CD-ROM includes PowerPoint slides and a variety of printable materials.

CHRISTMAS TREASURES (807162) A Collection of Congregational Resources for Advent/Christmas. This anthology provides a selection of seasonal worship, drama, and children's worship from a variety of denominations. Includes: readings for Advent and Christmas candle lighting, dramatic readings, plays, a Sunday school Christmas program, and children's sermons for Advent and Christmas.

Designed for use with children ages 6 - 8, each lesson includes a Bible story and an Earth-friendly craft using 'recycled' items that are common to most households. Includes Scripture index. Includes "And the Angel Said," "One Special Night," and "Follow That Star!"

MORE CHILDREN'S SERMONS (876411) Author: Dann, Bucky. Provides a basis for topics such as physical nature, sexuality, death, self-esteem, anger, the nature of God, discipleship, God's gifts, **Christmas**, dealing with evil, and the environment. Each unit has a suggested theme, object lesson, and dialogue to help children understand and grow in faith.

PASSING IT ON: HOW TO NURTURE YOUR CHILDREN'S FAITH SEASON BY SEASON (815174) Author: Oliver, Kara Lassen. Providing plans for four units (Advent -- preparing to receive the gifts of Christmas, Lent -- living in the awkward season, summer -- turning ordinary into extraordinary, and back-to-school -- growing fruit of the Spirit) this book provides plans for weekly family gatherings with age-appropriate activities. A leader's guide for parent groups using the book together is also provided.

PEANUT BUTTER, PAPER, AND PASTE (805224) Author: Gilliam, Brenda. Classroom Crafts and Recipes for the Seasons of the Church Year. Contains activities for Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, Easter, and Pentecost.

PRAISE GOD WITH BANNERS (805021) Author: Stohs, Anita Reith. Includes more than 40 Bible story banner ideas and patterns. Although intended for use with children in lower grades, they would also be appropriate for youth and adults. Each banner is designed to fit a 9" x 12" piece of felt as a personal banner. Note: instead of felt, you could use scrapbooking papers.
