### **Saint Mark's High School Middle School Band Camp**

When: June 18-22 2018, 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Who: Students who will be in Grades 6, 7, or 8 in September, 2018

Cost: \$110.00 per camper

Why: The purpose of the camp is to keep students playing during the summer months and to build on the skills they have learned at their schools during the school year.

The day will be broken up in segments:

- Warm up and chorale style playing- Students will play a simple chorale to learn to listen for intonation
- Technical exercises- We will explore different ways to play major and minor scales and chord arpeggios.
- Rehearsal techniques- We will rehearse several works and learn about the composers and the styles of the different pieces and their eras.
- Rehearsal of the works for a concert
