We often ask ourselves, “Why can’t these kids get along?” The primary role of the school-age practitioner is to teach social skills. We will discuss the whys and needs to teach social skills. Social skills will be broken down into seven skill clusters - known as The Seven Cs.

Participants will learn how to recognize the benefit of teaching social skills; understand how to support and teach The Seven Cs in the OST program which are: Confidence, Control, Coping, Curiosity, Communication, Community building and Conflict resolution. Participants will also analyze scenarios and classroom observations of children to determine how to implement appropriate social skills training.
