

## Some FAQ's:

- In the preliminary rounds, all Students AND Coaches will be getting 3 hits each.
- 2) All Students AND Coaches will be hitting Footballs off of a 'T' using ABO designated bats.
- Students can only participate in ONE chosen sport! (ie. if they play football and baseball, they mush CHOOSE ONE sport to represent.)
- 4) The girl student and boy student with the longest hit, that clears the set up fence, within their class, wins the "Longest Hit" Trophy for their class. Regardless of how many are hit over the fence. (Fresh/Soph/Junior/Senior)
- 5) The girl student and boy student that hits, in combination, the most Footballs and the longest ball over the set up fence from each team will represent their team in the Home Run Derby at the end of the day.
- 6) The Home Run Derby will be at the end of each Sports' time slot. Each team winner will have the opportunity to hit 7 footballs. The combination of the most over the fence and the greatest distance will be declared the winner. (example: if Student A hits 6 balls over the fence and the longest is 150' and Student B hits 5 balls over the fence and the longest is 155', Student A is the winner because of more hits over the fence.) Trophies will be awareded to both Girl and Boy winners.
- 7) Coaches have their own division and are encouraged to participate!! A trophy to the coach with the longest hit that clears the fence, in the regular hitting time with their teams, will win a trophy!
- 8) All donations should be collected ahead of time as a Flat Donation. It is a tremendous amount of work to have people donate by the distance hit and then have to collect afterwards.
- 9) All donations will need to be brought to Hit-a-Thon day, March 18th. That day the student will receive 2 raffle tickets if she/he collects and turns in \$25 or more. Some of the other prizes may be available that day as well (ie. water bottle)
- 10) Student athletes and coaches can participate in the hit-a-thon and home run derby, whether they collect donations or not. They will not, however, be eligible for donation prizes.
- 11) All teams are required to participate. 2017-2018 funding is dependent on it.
- All donations are tax deductible. WHS ABO is a 501(c)(3) non-profit.
