  - Compatible with agriculture




## Committed Neighbor

- First production in 60s
- E&B acquired 10 years ago
- 2 acres of rural land used for production
- \$1 million invested in infrastructure & safety
- Compatible with area's rural nature
- Veteran manages site




- Straightforward Process
  - Naturally occurring 20% oil 80% water pumped up
  - Cleaner water (hydrocarbons removed) with no beneficial reuse recycled back into oil reservoir
  - No fracking



## Environmentally Responsible

- Among lowest carbon intensities in CA
- Stays local
- No external water used in day-to-day operations
- Recycling water back into oil reservoir avoids trucking



E&B has had no effect on Livermore's water resources

- No effect on local groundwater from operations
  - Proven by substantial testing
- Nearest Public Water Supply Well is roughly 3.9 miles away from Livermore Field
- Responding to the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act, and after significant scientific and geological study, the State of California found that:

" E&B's oil reservoir ("aquifer") does not currently serve as a source of drinking water and going forward the oil reservoir is not reasonably expected to supply a public water system."


### Who Owns the Oil?

- Livermore Valley property owners with mineral rights
- Mineral lease agreements with property owners
- Royalty payments based on oil sales
- Can provide retirement income



## California Energy Independence

- Local oil production, distribution & consumption = less dependence on foreign oil
- All E&B oil produced in California stays in California
  - In-state use avoids impacts associated with overseas transportation
