Legal Aid of West Virginia advocates for West Virginia's veterans who have served in the military and fallen on hard times. Legal Aid seeks to provide comprehensive legal services by offering equal access to justice, and creating system change in order to improve client safety, health, housing, income, and access to resources.



Attorneys are available to help with legal issues in a variety of areas, including:

- **Veteran Benefits & Social Security Issues** (applying for disability, helping someone that has been turned down, other payments, etc.)
- **Public Benefits**
- **DMV** (Legal Aid does not pay fines or fees.)
- **Housing** (evictions, habitability, leases, HUD, Section 8, etc.)
- **Child Support**
- **Child Custody**
- **Unemployment Issues**
- **Criminal Expungement**
- **Consumer Issues** (debtor phone calls, lemon laws, contracts, etc.)
- **Tax Problems**
- **Power of Attorney**
- **Bankruptcy**
- **Estate Planning**

There may be free assistance if you have a legal problem or question and need help to:

- Achieve and maintain gainful employment
- Maintain safe and secure long term housing
- Secure all benefits to which you may be entitled
