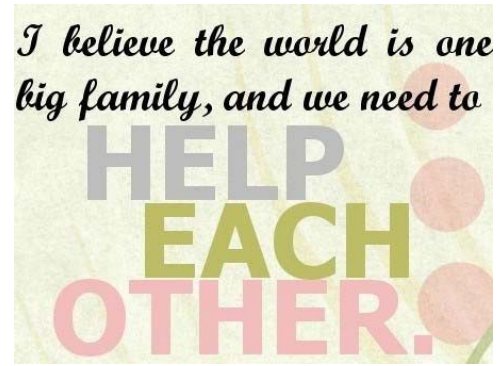
## About the Court Improvement Program
