Step

1

February 11, 2017
Start in your neighborhood

Precinct Caucus (Mass Meeting)

Early involvement begins at the grassroots level in your voting precinct. On February 11th, 2017 (Saturday) at 10am: Your county will gather at a designated place (watch your newspaper, county website, state website, or emails for the exact location). These gatherings are called the:

Precinct Caucus or Mass Meeting

At this caucus, you will meet with others in your precinct to elect officers (two year terms). You will also elect delegates and alternates to your County Convention held in March.

Step

3

April 22, 2017
District Conventions

These are based on U.S. Congressional Districts. Locations are decided by each individual district. If you were elected in March as a delegate or alternate to the District Convention, then you will be notified of the location.

At This Convention:

The Delegates will elect District Officers.

Note: Although you do not have to be present in Step 1 to be elected as a delegate or alternate from your precinct, at least one person must be present from your precinct in order to caucus. Attendance increases your chances of attending the County, District and State Conventions as a delegate or alternate.

Step

2

March 18, 2017
County Convention

Under 80,000 population counties will hold precinct caucuses at 9am immediately prior to the county convention. Your County GOP will hold a convention on Saturday, March 18th, 2017 at 10am at a place designated by your county party. If you are an elected delegate or alternate, you will receive a notice of the location.

Delegates who were elected at the February Mass Meeting or Caucus will gather to elect a County Chairman, Other Officers, and Committee Members as designated in your county bylaws for a two-year term. Delegates will also vote on who will represent your county at the District and State Conventions.

Step

4

June 2-3, 2017

The State Convention

This is where If you are an elected delegate or alternate you will receive a notice of the location.

If you were elected at your County Convention as a Delegate or Alternate to the state convention, then you will:

- Elect a new State Chairman - 2 year term
- Elect other State Party Officers - 2 year terms
