Tackling Erosion and Pollution



Stormwater Management Division tackles erosion and pollution through the use of bio-degradable tools in environmentally sensitive areas. The definition of natural erosion is the wearing away of the earth's surface by water and other natural agents under natural environmental conditions. The use of an erosion blanket called wheat straw matting is design to increase the strength and ability to maintain vegetation as a natural way to control erosion during the soil stabilization and germination period. As the matting degrades it enriches the soil while tackling erosion and allowing vegetation to effectively root. It is important to protect the natural environment but also important to protect ourselves. If it rains it drains!! Help keep our storm drains clean.
