How and Where to Dispose of Unwanted Medications

In Your Community

Other Options for Safe Disposal:



Local Police Departments - If your prescriptions contain narcotics or other controlled substances, contact your local police department to find out if the police will accept them.



Mail-Back Programs - The Wisconsin DEA allows mail-back programs for unused medications.



Drug Take Back Day - Whenever possible, take your unused prescription drugs to a collection program or event – the Wisconsin Department of Justice's DRUG TAKE BACK Days happen, at minimum, in the spring and fall of each year.



IMPORTANT! Drug Take Back is confidential - You may place your unused prescriptions into a plastic zipper lock bag, or remove the prescription label from the outside of the bottle.
