- You will receive an email confirmation of your summer camp registration. In the event that a camp is filled or cancelled due to low enrollment, you will be contacted by the Camp Coordinator to make alternative arrangements and a refund will be given. No refunds will be issued after June 1, 2017 to families who voluntarily withdraw from a summer program.
- Students who register for back-to-back camps will have a supervised lunch break. Students are responsible for bringing their own lunch and beverage each day.
- Art and academic camp check-in is held in the Pius XI main school lobby prior to that start of each camp time. Athletic camps meet in either the Pius XI Field House or at their designated park or field.
