1. BASIC Course

This course prepares the person to serve the church, through ministries of leading, caring, communicating &/or speaking.

This course is REQUIRED for Lay Servants, Lay Speakers, and Certified Lay Ministers before proceeding to advanced certified courses.

2. POLITY

This course can be used for certification as a Lay Servant.

This course is required for certification as a Lay Speaker.

3. PREACHING

This course is required for certification as a Lay Speaker.

This course can be used for certification as a Lay Servant.

This course is designed for those who have not had formal preaching training, for pastors seeking a refresher course & others who are called to preach in a pastor's absence.

This course does not qualify for certification.

WHAT IS A LAY SPEAKER?

CERTIFIED LAY SERVANT – REVISED 2017

A Certified Lay Servant serves the local church or beyond the local church through leadership, assistance, support with program emphases; lead meetings for prayer, training, study or discussion; conduct or assist in conducting services of worship; preach the Word when requested by the pastor, district superintendent or committee on Lay Servant Ministries; work on committees that provide congregational or community leadership; assist in Holy Communion; teach the scriptures, doctrine, organization and ministries of the UM church.

Requirements:

1. Obtain recommendation from the pastor and the charge conference.
2. Complete *Introduction to Lay Ministries: The BASIC course*.
3. Complete one advanced Lay Servant Ministries course after completing the BASIC course.
The course possibilities are: Discovering Your Spiritual Gifts, Leading Prayer, Leading Worship, United Methodist Heritage, United Methodist Polity, Preaching
4. Apply to and have qualifications reviewed by the district committee on Lay Servant Ministries.

To Maintain status as a Certified Lay Servant:

1. Submit an annual report and renewal application to the charge conference and to the district committee.
(The Pastor will give you this report to turn in at the church charge conference.)
2. Obtain recommendation for renewal from Pastor and charge conference.
3. Complete a Lay Servant Ministries advance course every 3 years.

CERTIFIED LAY SPEAKER – REVISED 2017

A Certified Lay Speaker serves by preaching the Word when requested by the pastor, district superintendent, or committee on Lay Servant Ministries.

Requirements:

1. Be a certified Lay Servant (requirements listed above).
2. Obtain recommendation from pastor and charge conference.
3. Complete a track of study including courses on Leading Worship, Leading Prayer, Discovering Spiritual Gifts, Preaching, United Methodist Heritage & United Methodist Polity.
4. Interview with and obtain recommendation from district committee on Lay Servant Ministries.

To maintain status as Certified Lay Speaker:

1. Submit an annual report and renewal application to the charge conference and to the district committee.
(The Pastor will give you this report to turn in at the church charge conference.)
2. Obtain recommendation for renewal from Pastor and charge conference.
3. Complete a Lay Servant Ministries advance course every 3 years.
