He was the lead federal negotiator for the Canada-Ontario Labour Market Development Agreement that transferred Employment Insurance funded labour market programs and services to the Province of Ontario on January 1, 2007. Since retiring from the Federal Public Service in 2013, he has been active in the not-for-profit sector as a volunteer and consultant with the Ontario Non-Profit Network (ONN), United Way of Toronto and York Region (UWTYR) and other organizations. He is currently Chair of the St. Stephens Community House Board of Directors.
