- Outline of presentation content
- Promotional statement/images (to advertise to Chamber members)
- Audio/visual supports needed
- Presentation materials to be distributed and any support that may be required
- Testimonial(s) from past clients
- Video of past workshops/seminars OR availability to present your topic to the Chamber staff
