CNLP status is earned through practical experience in the industry, passing a written test that reviews the basics of our industry and making a commitment to continuing education.

OBJECTIVES

One objective is to provide education for horticultural industry professionals. This includes arborists, turf professionals, landscape gardeners and contractors, parks and institutional grounds employees and retail garden center employees. It's also designed as a review session to prepare those interested in taking the exam to attain status as a Certified Nursery Landscape Professional (CNLP).

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR CNLP?

Any individual who meets the following requirements is eligible to apply for CNLP status:

- Is a graduate from a recognized 2 or 4 year college with a degree in the horticulture field
OR
- Has completed 3 years of experience in the horticultural industry.
