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Quarter 1, 2018: Relationship Alphabet Soup

Friday, February 9, 2018 • 9–10 a.m. (MT)

Decision-making authority impacts admission, discharge, and post-discharge processes: *Understand legally defined relationships such as guardianship, powers of attorney, and other advance directives to help improve patient outcomes with less stress and delay.*

Quarter 2, 2018: Inpatient Psychiatric Treatment: A Preview

Friday, May 11, 2018 • 9–10 a.m. (PT)

It's not like the movies: *Positive and negative misperceptions about inpatient psychiatric treatment; observe several different inpatient settings and learn what typical treatment plans look like.*

Quarter 3, 2018: Changing the Stigma and Images of ECT

Electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) conjures up frightening and very outdated images. ECT is used to augment counseling and medication with some of the most resistant and potentially disabling symptoms: *Learn what ECT looks like today, what diagnoses it is used for, and outcomes.*

Quarter 4, 2018: SSI/SSDI: Similar but Very Different

Insufficient resources often lead to crisis and inpatient admission, yet approval for and maintenance of these benefits is confusing and overwhelming: *How Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) are alike and different; application, approval, and denial processes and tips.*

Quarter 1, 2019: Dementia in More Detail

It is more than memory loss or senility: *Types of dementia, signs, and symptoms of onset. How formal diagnosis is determined, treatment options, and prognosis.*

Quarter 2, 2019: Caregiving: Mindfulness and Resources
