Foster Care & Adoptive Community

The FCAC has over 150 online training courses that the foster parents can take when they want; from wherever they want. The courses are developed by professionals with extensive experience, and most hold a Masters or Ph. D. Certificates are immediately generated upon completion of the course and passing of the test.

There is a fee for the online courses, however prices range from \$5.95 up to \$11.95 depending on the number of credit hours offered.
