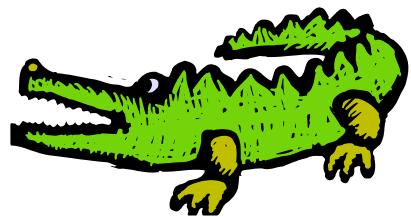




Please pick up awards!




The Means Family




The Lewis Family
