[Jesus said] Be constantly on the watch! Keep alert! You do not know when the time will come. It is like people traveling abroad. They leave their home and put the workers in charge, each with a certain task, and those who watch at the front gate are ordered to stay active and alert. So stay alert! You do not know when the owner of the house is coming, whether at dusk, at midnight, when the rooster crows, or at early dawn. Do not let the owner come suddenly and catch you asleep. What I say to you, I say to all: Stay awake!
