

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost to be a craft fair vendor? It's completely FREE to be a part of the Craft Fair and it's FREE to attend! Sew Crafty will provide everyone with a table and chairs.

How many items does my child need to make? We ask all vendors to make 10 (ten) or more items each to sell. All crafts must be handmade by a child or with the assistance of a parent. And no worries, Honeycomb and Sew Crafty staff will handle all of the monetary transactions and will be there to help at the fair.

What type of items can be sold at the Craft Fair? Be as creative as you'd like! Some ideas include: magnets, candles, bracelets, pillowcases, scarves, bookmarks, slime, hair clips, photo frames, tie-dye tees, key chains, flower pots, tote bags and more! If your child loves to bake, we welcome baked goodies at Sew Crafty (cupcakes, nut-free bars, dog treats, etc).

I have more than one child that would like to participate...can I register more than one child? Of course! You can register all the children in your family. To register please email Jodie at info@sewcraftystudio.com. Simply let Jodie know what day(s) they will be selling their crafts (they are welcome to participate on Saturday and/or Sunday).

My child has friends from school that want to be vendors, can they participate? Yes, the more the merrier! Feel free to share the love and invite friends to create handmade crafts and raise funds for Honeycomb. Friends can even share a table.

Who are the customers shopping at the Craft Fair? Anyone you know...it's FREE to attend! We need your help in spreading the word. Share the Craft Fair event with your community—friends, aunts, uncles, cousins, neighbors, teachers, coaches...the sky's the limit!

What else should my family do before the day(s) of the Craft Fair? Get crafty! Please make a vendor sign/name (example: Jodie's Jewels) for your table and have your family create your own pricing/tags. Prior to the Craft Fair, you will receive detailed instructions regarding set-up and parking for the event at Sew Crafty Studio, located at 2340 N. Clybourn Avenue.
