Empowering Noyce Apprenticeships By Leadership Engagement in STEM Teaching

ENABLE STEM is a one-year (summer, fall and spring) Master of Education (MEd) degree program in the Department of Teaching and Learning at The Ohio State University. The program prepares and supports high quality STEM teacher leaders in high-needs classrooms in grades 7-12. Students from underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply.

Fellowship Details:

- Must be a U.S. citizen, national, or alien admitted as a refugee residing in Ohio
- \$10,000 stipend provided first year in the MEd program, plus full-tuition support
- Additional \$10,000 salary supplement paid each year for four years teaching in high-needs schools
- Must apply to the graduate-level teacher education program in mathematics or science (MEd) by **November 15, 2016**
- Explore informal learning at COSI, the Center of Science and Industry
