ConnectiKids, Inc. is an after school academic enhancement program for Hartford elementary youth. One day each week for 75 minutes, students meet individually with a tutor/mentor. Tutors work with students using a literacy-based curriculum that reinforces educational frameworks currently used in Hartford Public Schools.

Our Mission: Inspiring Hartford's children to make positive choices, embrace high expectations and fulfill their potential by providing successful mentors, individualized tutoring, enriching activities and stimulating environments.

- Mentors meet on Tuesdays for 75 minutes with their student
- 5-8 Grade students from M.D. Fox Elementary School are transported by bus to the tutoring site
- Mentoring is supervised by a ConnectiKids, Inc. staff member at all times
- Mentoring times are from 3:30pm to 4:45pm
- A background check is required for all mentors 18 years & older
- As a volunteer training will be provided to familiarize you with the program
- Lesson plan and all needed materials will be provided.
- A calendar of tutoring dates is provided to all Mentors. The schedule is created around the site/agency school or work schedule
- Programming is held regularly in **room 311 in the Undergraduate Building**
- The program runs from late October to late April
