

Covenant of Conduct:

In signing this covenant, I agree to live by the following guidelines during Resurrection. I WILL....

- Respect the health of my own body by refraining from the use of alcohol, tobacco, and drugs of any kind, except those prescribed by a doctor or physician.
- Respect the physical and emotional well-being of other youth and adults by “doing unto others as I would have them do unto me” (respecting the need for sleep, refraining from harmful practical jokes, etc.)
- Respect property! (Hotel, bus, convention center, etc.)
- Respect the opposite sex by staying out of guys’ rooms if I am a girl and girls’ rooms if I am a guy. (No Purple)
- Be respectful of check-in times.
- I will not bring any weapons of any kind (youth worker’s discretion) & if I buy anything that could remotely be considered a weapon, I will give it to an adult immediately for safe keeping.

# What is Resurrection?

Resurrection is an exciting weekend for Holston Conference youth. This year is the 32nd anniversary of this event. Over 12,000 youth are expected to attend this year’s Resurrection Youth Conference. During this experience, you will encounter the Lord in new and deeper ways. For many people, Resurrection is an opportunity for “conversion,” “decision,” and “revival.” For others, it becomes a moment of realization that their faith needs to grow deeper and more serious. It is also a time for the youth of our church to bond together and establish close friendships with one another.

## The Message: Mick Veach

Whether smuggling Bibles, feeding lepers or planting a church among an unreached Islamic nation, Mick Veach’s commitment to share the love of God with the lost has taken him to the ends of the earth.



Now as a mission-minded pastor and speaker, Mick desires to see God’s truth compel others to Great Commission action and to foster healthy local churches that engage in evangelism and discipleship.

Mick has served as a Global Partners’ Area Director for Central Asia and the Middle East and has presented the gospel in more than 60 countries. He and his wife, Melanie, have three children.

## When & Where:

Resurrection is held at the LeConte Center in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. The dates are January 20-22, 2017. We will leave on Friday at 4:00pm and we will return on Sunday around 6:30pm. Late transportation for kids unable to leave at 4:00pm will be provided. Please call Troy Hamilton or Sara Holley at the church (423-756-2021) to make the arrangements.



## How much does it cost?

The total cost is \$130 per person. The entire balance for the trip is due by January 8th. (\$150 after January 8th- if space is still available). The youth will also need spending money for 4 meals, free time activities, T-shirts, souvenirs, etc. which they may want to buy. We provide breakfast on Saturday & Sunday.

Parents who have more than one child: Your cost is \$130 for the 1st child & \$65 for each additional child.

## What should students bring?

A Bible, pen, note pad, warm clothes, a towel, toiletries, guys bring two 2-liter drinks, and girls bring snacks.

## Free Time:

Students will have a choice between three or four scheduled activities. These are still being determined but will likely be: Gatlinburg Activities, Shopping, Lazer Tag (\$25), Go Carts (\$40), or the traditional Putt-Putt Challenge/ Arcade (\$25). The youth will need spending money for these activities. We recommend a minimum of \$100.

If students choose Gatlinburg as their free time option: All youth (grades 6-9) are required to have at least one adult with them at all times. Only youth in grades 10-12 will be permitted to roam Gatlinburg in groups of three or more without an adult (unless their parent/guardian requests that he/she stay with an adult- be sure to check the box on the next page).

## Accommodations:

We are VERY excited about our accommodations for this year’s Resurrection trip! We have rented a giant luxury lodge. It is called the “Big Elk Lodge” and will sleep up to 74 people. It has 16 different rooms, a 21 seat theater room, a game room, large dining and living rooms, and a huge kitchen.
