

Covenant of Conduct:

In signing this covenant, I agree to live by the following guidelines during Resurrection. I WILL....

- Respect the health of my own body by refraining from the use of alcohol, tobacco, and drugs of any kind, except those prescribed by a doctor or physician.
- Respect the physical and emotional well-being of other youth and adults by “doing unto others as I would have them do unto me” (respecting the need for sleep, refraining from harmful practical jokes, etc.)

Rev. Rachel Billups serves as Ginghamburg's Executive Pastor of Discipleship and as part of the preaching team.

Rachel, an Ordained Elder within the United Methodist Church, holds a Bachelor's Degree in Bible/Religion and History from Anderson University and a Master of Divinity degree from Duke Divinity School. Rachel was also the first clergy resident for the United Methodist West Ohio Conference's Residency Program. Before joining the Ginghamburg team in July 2014, Rachel served as the lead pastor of Shiloh United Methodist, a multisite church in Cincinnati, Ohio.

When & Where:

Resurrection will be held at the LeConte Center in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee on January 19-21, 2018. We will leave on Friday at 4:00pm and we will return on Sunday around 6:30pm. Late transportation for kids unable to leave at 4:00pm will be provided. Please call Troy Hamilton or Sara Holley (423-756-2021) to make the arrangements.

How much does it cost?

The total cost for students is \$130 per person. The entire balance for the trip is due by January 7th. (\$150 after January 7th- if space is still available). The youth will also need spending money for 4 meals, free time activities, T-shirts, souvenirs, etc. which they may want to buy. We provide breakfast on Saturday & Sunday.

Parents who have more than one child: Your cost is \$130 for the 1st child & then \$50 off for each additional child.

What should students bring?

A Bible, pen, note pad, warm clothes, a towel, toiletries, a sleeping bag, guys bring two 2-liter drinks, and girls bring snacks.

Free Time:

Students will spend their Saturday free time in Gatlinburg. Here are the traditional things our students spend their money on during free time: Shopping, Lazer Tag (\$25), Go Carts (\$40), and the traditional Putt-Putt Challenge/Arcade (\$25). The youth will need spending money for these activities & meals. We recommend a minimum of \$100.

All youth (grades 6-9) are required to have at least one adult with them at all times. Only youth in grades 10-12 will be permitted to roam Gatlinburg in groups of three or more without an adult (unless their parent/guardian requests that he/she stay with an adult- be sure to check the box on the next page).
