












BACKGROUND

The SADC Industrialisation Week (SIW) is an annual public-private engagement platform aimed at fostering new opportunities for intra-African trade and investment in the Southern Africa region. The event is hosted as a precursor to the SADC Heads of State and Government Summit and its outputs are reported to the annual SADC Ministers Meeting.

In August 2015, the SADC Heads of State Summit urged Member States to popularize the SADC Industrialisation Strategy and Roadmap at a national level. On the margins of that Summit, the NEPAD Business Foundation (NBF) hosted a Southern Africa Business Forum (SABF) consultative conference in Botswana whose outcomes were captured in the 'Savuti Declaration' which was circulated to Member States as private sector's input into

the SADC Industrialisation Strategy.

In 2016, the SADC Secretariat recognised the SABF as the official partner in the implementation of the SADC Industrialisation Strategy and Roadmap and in August 2016, the inaugural SIW event was commemorated in Matsapha, Swaziland on the margins of the 2016 SADC Heads of State Summit. Main outcomes of the event resulted into the 'Esibayeni Declaration' which also was circulated to SADC Heads of State.

In 2017, the second SIW event was hosted in Sunninghill, South Africa and produced the 'Sunninghill declaration' which outlines a plan of action for private sector to take the lead in ensuring an expedient industrialisation of the region.
