Meeting called to order by President Jay Pagano in the Solstice Room, Whyte Hall, Fire Island Pines, NY.

Pines Party

Baum, Pines Party Co-Chair, reported:

- 2016 Pines Party will exceed its goal of \$200,000 profit.
- The Co-Chairs are recommending that Stonewall receive the same amount as last year.
- Baum submitted an [Analysis of Pines Party Revenues and Expenses](#).

Baum motioned that the Foundation donate \$50,000 to Stonewall, the same amount as last year, from the Pines Party proceeds. Saray seconded and the motion carried.

Pines Care Center

Ed Schulhafer Reported:

- The Pines Care Center (PCC), did not reach its fundraising goals earlier in the season.
 - Raised about \$20,000 by hosting a “bridge the gap” party.
 - As a user group, PCC occupies 15% of the Whyte Hall.
 - Each year, PCC has contributed 15% of the expenses of Whyte Hall.
- The PCC budget was affected by the change in the fact that doctors are now paid \$2,000 a week for their service.
 - PCC is the only medical facility on Fire Island staffed by MDs.
 - The other clinics are staffed by physician assistants and nurses.
- The PCC gets a significant number of patients from Cherry Grove.
- The Care center will change its fundraising next year and will institute a quarterly newsletter.
