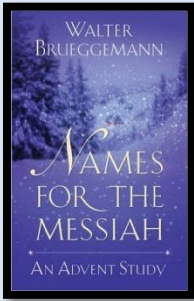
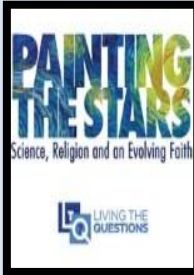

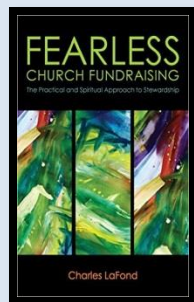
“Names for the Messiah: An Advent Study” by Walter Brueggemann (WJK Press)

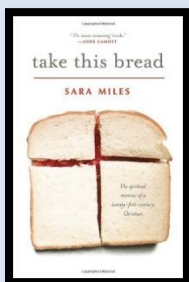
“Painting the Stars: Science, Religion and an Evolving Faith” by miscellaneous contributors (Living the Question)
