Seeks qualified individuals for the position of **Seasonal Shift Backfill**

This position is a “call when needed” position for the purpose of backfilling shift vacancies created during wildland fire season when Full-Time personnel staff an apparatus for a resource assignment. These shift availabilities come with anything from immediate need to several days in advance.

Vernon Fire District works a standard 48/96 schedule with a two person crew. Our average yearly call volume is 300. Vacancies may be either 24 or 48 hours. We are flexible and can work with your availability whether for a full or partial shift.

Requirements:

- **AZ FF I&II certification**
- **Current AZ EMT Basic or higher certification**
- **Current Healthcare Provider CPR certification**
- **Red Card Certified**
- **Have completed and submitted all VFD hiring requirements-** this is to enroll personnel in VFD’s payroll system. Requirements will include valid AZ driver’s license. To be able successful pass DMV check, background check and a drug test.

Duties:

Assist on-duty personnel with daily truck checks and normal station chores and respond to 911 calls as dispatched. Most are EMS with 20-40 minutes on-scene patient care occurring prior to ambulance arrival. Equipment familiarization, pump operations and drivers training would occur while backfilling.

Pay: current pay for 24 hours in this position is \$240 plus extra pay for night calls.
