Have you picked-up your "Forever" Card?

Effective April 1, 2017, the new membership access card or better known as the "**Forever Card**" will be fully operational and the "swipe cards" will be discontinued. All cards will be programmed into a proximity reader to improve access, eliminate the need to have a new card made every year, help gather facility usage data, and better monitor safety/security issues. **HOW DOES IT WORK?** When you approach any access point, all you need to do is waive or tap your new card on the black box. Please be aware that if your assessment fees are not paid-up prior to March 31st, you will not be able to access the gates. To use your card to play golf, tennis, or pool, you can purchase the **Amenity** package or pay the daily fee. If you are a resident (12 yrs. or older) in good standing, you can now pick-up your "forever card" at the office. As we get busier in the office, we want to thank you in advance for your patience. **NOTE:** If you lose your card, there will be a \$10 replacement and re-activation fee.
