2019 ICE SPECTACULAR
SHOWTIME for Junior Club Members

April 5th, 6th & 7th

The North Shore Skating Club JUNIOR CLUB members will be participating in our annual ice show “ICE SPECTACULAR” again this year. We expect to fill the Burbank Ice Arena in Reading for three spectacular show performances! All Junior Club skaters of every level are invited to participate. Adult Junior Club members should see separate Adult Show Application.

Last year was a wonderful experience for all participants. Once again, we will have groups divided and performing by age and level. Jr. Club members will perform in two out of the three show performances. The show will also feature Senior Club skaters as well as our nationally-ranked Theatre on Ice Teams. The show’s theme will be announced in January.

In order to do the show, we must receive a completed show application with payment in full and the skater must be enrolled in Junior Club classes and/or contracted on a practice session by the Junior Club Show Application Deadline of Saturday, November 17, 2018 and must remain enrolled through the end of Session III. The cost of Session III classes and/or contracted practice sessions cannot be pro-rated for skaters participating in the Ice Spectacular and skaters enrolled in the Ice Spectacular are required to pay for and regularly attend their Session III classes or contracted practice session. Since the show numbers are group numbers, there must be a commitment to make all rehearsals including the dress rehearsal unless you are very ill. All skaters are required to be on the ice ON TIME for each practice session.

ALL PRACTICES WILL BE HELD AT THE BURBANK ICE ARENA IN READING. If you have a serious conflict with one of the two half-hour Saturday rehearsal times, a rehearsal date, or with one of the show performances, it must be noted on the application at the time it is submitted. All absences must be approved by the Show Committee. If a skater cannot make any of the half hour practice times on the Saturdays listed below, he/she should not sign up to participate. Every effort will be made to accommodate legitimate conflicts noted on the application, however, if the conflict cannot be accommodated, your application and show fee will be returned prior to our ordering show costumes. NO REFUNDS will be made after costumes have been ordered.

All groups are formulated by the Show Committee. Skaters are assigned to groups according to their age and badge level at the time of the application deadline with some consideration going to the child’s height as well as the number of participants needed for each group. Because of the large number of families with more than one skater involved in our show, we regret that it is impossible to guarantee that all skaters within a family will be skating in the same show performance. If it is absolutely necessary that all family members be in the same show performance, it must be noted on the application at the time it is submitted. In order to accommodate any such request, the show committee reserves the right to put children in lower age or skating levels than to which they otherwise would have been assigned. Please be aware that this special consideration will be given to immediate family members only. Also, please note that we have many children of the same age and level and we cannot guarantee that children will be in the same show groups as their friends. Even children in the same group class are not always assigned to the same show group. **All show groups are final and will not be changed.**

If paying online, applications may be handed in at the Junior Club desk or scanned & emailed to nsscjc@nsskating.org. Measurements will be taken Thursday, November 15th and Saturday, November 17th at the Burbank Rink during Junior Club hours.

REQUIREMENTS TO BE IN THE SHOW

COST: \$140.00 for the first family member, \$120.00 for each additional family member

Includes the following:

- *Costume (which you keep)
- *Coaches fees
- *Ice Costs
- *One adult ticket per family for each performance to which at least one family member is assigned

COSTUMES: All show costumes are chosen by the Show Committee. This Committee orders costumes based on each skater's measurements and the sizing charts provided by the costume companies. Measurements will be taken during Junior Club hours only by the Show Committee on Thursday, November 15th and Saturday, November 17th at the Burbank Rink. These will be the only times skaters will be measured. **All alterations and costs incurred for them are the responsibility of the show participant** and must be done in such a way as to keep the costume consistent with the rest of the costumes in the participant's group. It should be understood that these costumes are theatrical and are intended for the purpose of the show performances only. Skaters should not expect that costumes will be of later use.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ADS / TICKET SALES: This year a promotional packet will be available to all Junior Club show skaters; however, participation in the ad campaign is optional for Junior Club skaters. Show tickets will be available for sale during Junior Club hours starting a few weeks prior to the show, at dress rehearsal, and at the door at all performances. We like to advertise the show in local newspapers and online. Please complete the name release portion of the application to let us know whether or not we can list your skater's name in the articles that will be in print and online about the show.

VOLUNTEERS: We can always use parental help with the show and would greatly appreciate it if anyone would be willing to volunteer. We always need help in the following areas: Costumes (locating, sewing, and/or distributing), playing music during rehearsals, monitoring rehearsals, monitoring picture day, monitoring groups during the show, props, spotlights, set-up and break-down, ticket distribution, T-shirt distribution, phone calls.
