The reaction time variability (RTV) study is looking for children between the ages of 8 and-12 years with and without a diagnosis of ADHD to participate in a fMRI brain imaging study. The RTV study aims to improve the lives of children with attention, behavior, and academic problems by examining brain functioning in kids.

- Coming to FIU for two, 1-2 hour sessions.
- Parent and child will answer questions about the child, complete questionnaires, and complete a brief intelligence and academic screener to assess study eligibility.
- Eligible children will be asked to complete computer tasks while undergoing a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) scan.
