Long QT Syndrome Screening and SIDS Prevention

Despite a tremendous public health effort, SIDS remains the number 1 killer of infants beyond the first month of life. Recent scientific discoveries have brought new hope that some SIDS deaths can be prevented. Dr. Chang will discuss his research on SIDS prevention at LA BioMed in the last 10 years.

Dr. Chang is a pediatric cardiologist studying new technologies that can be developed to help prevent poor outcomes in newborns with heart disease. In addition to being a researcher at LA BioMed, Dr. Chang is the Founder and CEO of QT Medical, Inc., a spinoff company of LA BioMed that specializes in cardiagnostic devices. The first product is QT Screen — a super-compact, digital, wireless 12-lead ECG designed specifically for long QT syndrome screening in babies. Dr. Chang will unveil the QT Screen service at the Annual Meeting of the American Academy of Pediatrics in October 2016 (San Francisco). In this presentation, he will demonstrate a preview of the QT Screen service, which will be launched in California in 2017.



FROM THE NORTH

Take the 110 South. Exit onto Carson Street. Turn right onto West Carson Street. Take the 2nd left onto South Vermont Avenue. Turn right onto West 220th Street. Turn right onto Meyler Street. Turn left onto South Drive. The CDCRC is on the left.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take the 110 North. Exit toward Carson Street. Keep right and continue to Figueroa Street. Turn right onto Figueroa Street. Turn right onto West 223rd Street. Turn right onto South Vermont Avenue. Turn left onto West 220th Street. Turn right onto Meyler Street. Turn left onto South Drive. The CDCRC is on the left.

FROM THE WEST

Go east on West Carson. Turn right onto Normandie Avenue. Turn left onto 220th Street. Take the first left. Turn right onto South Drive. The CDCRC is on the right.

FROM THE EAST

Take the 405 North. Exit toward Avalon Boulevard South. Merge onto East Carson Street. Turn left onto South Vermont Avenue. Turn right onto West 220th Street. Turn right onto Meyler Street. Turn left onto South Drive. The CDCRC is on the left.
