Student and Parent Commitment

I understand that it is a privilege to join the Maker's Club and I agree to use the equipment responsibly and treat club members with respect.

With respect to flying drones, under the FAA certificate for unmanned aircraft (UAS), students agree that they will abide by the following rules

- Fly below 400 feet
- Never fly near other aircraft
- Keep your UAS within visual line of sight
- Keep away from emergency responders
- Never fly over stadiums, sports events or groups of people
- Never fly under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Never fly within 5 miles of an airport without first contacting air traffic control and airport authorities

Parent(s) acknowledge and agree that, in the event of any: (a) injury or damage to equipment/facilities or any property, whether real or personal; and/or (b) any injury to any person occurs as a result of the student's actions, while participating in the UAS activity, the parent(s) agree to be held jointly and severally liable for all costs, including legal fees, incurred and/or associated with the student's actions.

Parents are responsible for picking up their child no later than 4:50pm.

Parents agree to give ECCA permission to photograph, and record their child for use in audio, video, film, or other electronic, digital and printed media. To opt out of photography please see Miss Bell.
